Dale announced that there were 57 paid members with more who have expressed interest in joining. There are also 15 new members. 26 members were represented at the evening's event.

Dale also reviewed the Chambers participation in 2006 as Co-sponsor for Family Fun Day as well as the Chamber's first golf outing, which raised money for the 911 fund as well as the Tuxedo Volunteer Ambulance Corps.

She also stated that the Ambulance Corps will be presented with \$1000 at the Chamber's first meeting of 2007. The money was raised during the golf outing on September 11th and was voted in the October 2006 meeting that a portion of the proceeds collected would be donated to the Ambulance Corps as a kick-off to their 50th anniversary fund raising year.

Dale also made mention of the Tuxedo Local Sign Law and that the Chamber finds it to be not so friendly. If businesses need any assistance with the sign law to contact the Chamber.

Dale is encouraging that businesses show participation by attending at least three meeting for 2007. Help is needed to discuss ideas and for input on attracting new members. The proposed Bi-Law revision vote needs to be cast before December 22nd. The Bi-law would amend officer's terms to 2 years.
